Aim:

The following table displays the ongoing partnerships developed between Scoil Iosagain Primary School and outside agencies. The emphasis is generally on providing all pupils with interventions to ensure the maximum participation in school and in school activities however some interventions are for individual pupils. These partnerships have been developed over a number of years and further partnerships are continually nurtured. As a school we work in partnership on an ongoing basis with agencies such as NEPS, TUSLA, EWO and the HSE. As such these statutory agencies have not been included in our DEIS planning. Our main aim is to promote partnership with outside agencies and companies, with the view of enabling and enhancing better educational achievement in the children

2. To strengthen social emotional literacy of children through pupils, teachers and the class environment
